TRIP TO KIBURARA, WESTERN UGANDA JANUARY 2025

Again I was invited to speak to the young people in Kiburara, Western Uganda for Covenant Global Ministries led by Pastor Moses Nkwatsibwe.

YOUTH CAMP

East Africa has among the highest population growth in the world, and I felt privileged for the opportunity to make an impact on around 400 young people at the camp.

I preached about Paul's relationship with Timothy, and the need for godly sexuality in this generation, biblical leadership and gospel foundations (the theme of the camp was 'rebuilding the foundation' Psalm 11:3).

Many of the youth responded and were greatly encouraged. I enjoyed building friendships with some of the youth and getting to know their stories.

After the youth camp I spent time training Elders and Pastors for Pastor Moses Nkwatsibwe. Thereafter I did some marriage counselling, and my small effort helped towards a group wedding which took place later in the year.



TCI – TRANSFORMED COMMUNITIES INTERNATIONAL

As a board member of the TCI (transformed communities international) I was invited to their donor function in Washington DC in October. Thankfully I was well enough to attend the function and be updated by my friends Frank and Sue Robb about the amazing work being done in Uganda. TCI works in Kiburara, Western Uganda and Karamoja in Northeastern Uganda which borders on Kenya and South Sudan. The Karamojong people are a largely unreached people group. Due to the prolonged drought in the area TCI has been giving bimonthly emergency famine relief which has kept hundreds of people alive over the last two years. The also assisted the community to sink a borehole, begin vegetable gardens and introduced oral bible storytelling to promote the gospel. Much relational trust has now been established within the Karamojong community

The work in Western Uganda led by Pastor Moses and his wife Sarah involve education and community transformation and sustainability.

My role has been to give gospel and leadership training for the important work TCI are doing. The TCI website address is www.tcius.org.

Francis has a unique pioneering apostolic gift, and his team are doing an extremely significant gospel work in large parts of rural Madagascar as well as establishing clinics and larger scale farming. Francis is also working in the surrounding islands of Mauritius, Seychelles, Mayotte, Maldives and Réunion. It is a real joy to witness what God is doing in Madagascar and the growing number of people responding to the gospel!
